Digital Assets in Europeana: 5,401,420 (on 17 January 2018)

Funding

Since 2008, Norway has contributed €180,000 to the funding of Europeana.

To date, Europeana contributed €47,280 from the budget of the EU to fund Europeana projects in Norway.

Participation in projects

Currently there are no Norwegian partners in EU-funded projects that contribute to Europeana. Participation in projects directly support knowledge and technology sharing between libraries, museums, archives, software agencies and university research departments. The activities include delivering content, technology and knowledge to Europeana.



Aggregation to Europeana

Europeana Collections features over 50 million records of which 5,401,420 are provided by Norwegian Institutions. Most records are provided by LoCloud and Arts Council Norway. All records aggregated by Norway can be found [here](#)¹. The main point of contact in Norway is Kulturråd.

Data Partners

Open Licenses Data

65.5% of the 5,401,420 objects in Europeana provided by Norway is openly licensed³. 50% of these objects are shown with the internationally accredited Public Domain mark⁴, 4.3% is licensed under CC BY-SA⁵, 9,4% is licensed under CC0⁶ and 1.9% is licensed under CC BY⁷. Openly Licensed data is important as it allows contribution of content to education, Creative Industries, exhibitions and the like.

Europeanana Network Association

The Europeanana Network Association is a dedicated group of experts working in the field of digital heritage. To this date 16 people from Norway have registered to become a Europeanana Network Association Member.

Every year the Europeanana Network Association elects the Members Council consisting of 36 members who play a crucial role across all Europeanana's activities.

Also the Members Council appoints six members to form its Management Board, who sit on the Europeanana Governing Board and represent the Network in the Europeanana Foundation's executive decision making.

In 2017, Lars Rogstad from the Norwegian Directorate for Cultural Heritage got elected to be part of the Members Council for the next two years.
