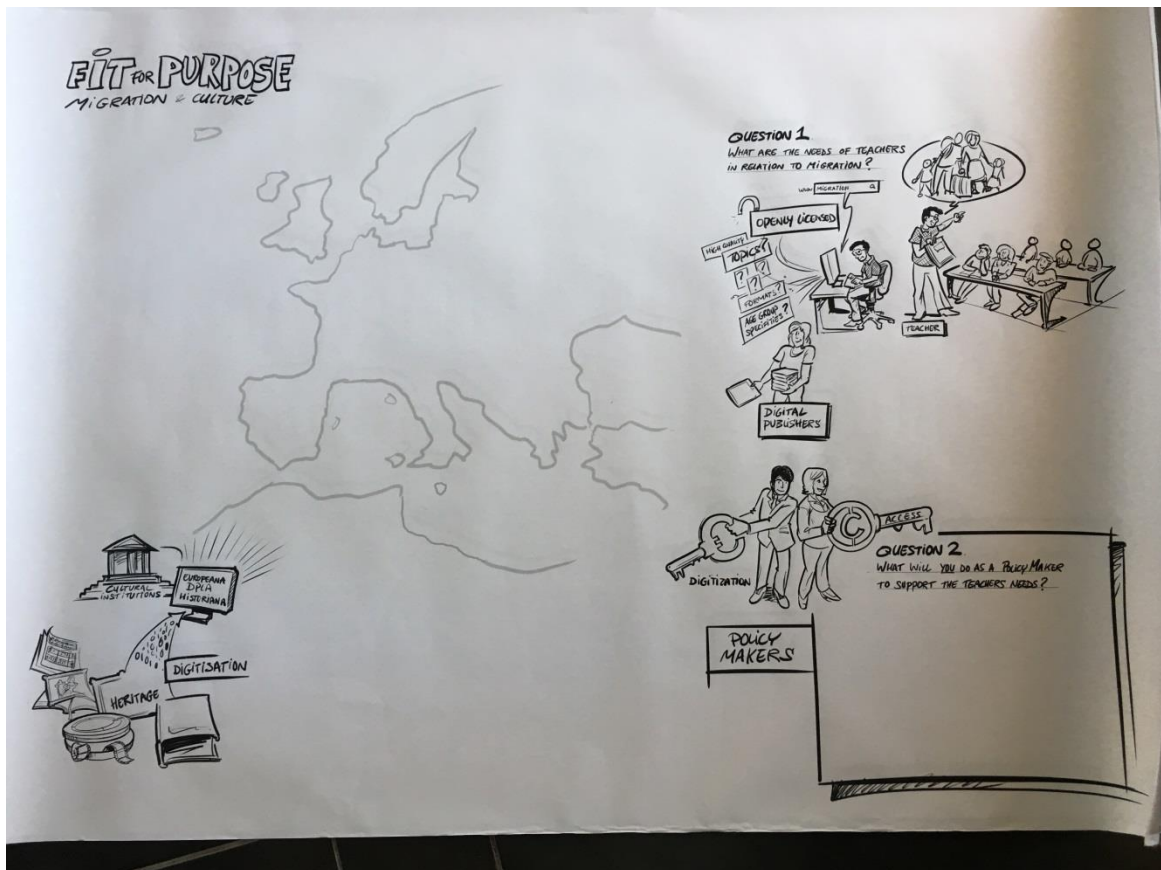


Maltese Presidency Conference “Migration and Culture - how can our past educate our present”

This *invite only* 1.5 day meeting was organised under the auspices of the Europeana DSI2 by Europeana Foundation and the Ministry of Education through the National Archives in Malta during the Maltese Presidency and took place at the Conference centre of Hagar Qim on 23 and 24 May 2017.

This Presidency meeting, a high-level strategy meeting, primarily targeted policymakers of EU member states, as a means to raise awareness among them about what Europeana does and how it can help them in their own work. At this meeting policymakers and experts in the education field discussed ways to stimulate and facilitate the re-use of Europeana’s available material.

The event addressed how Cultural Heritage Institutions can better cater for migration themes to respond to the requirements of the community of educators.



The purpose of this event was also to build on the “Europeana for Education Policy Recommendations” designed in May 2015, and more specifically “Recommendation II. Prioritise the provision of ‘Fit for Education and Learning’ content by cultural heritage institutions and ministries”.



The event was very successful with nearly 40 participants from education and cultural heritage ministries, with some excellent talks from a wide range of speakers. A draft set of results are expected before the summer.

Estonian Presidency

Under the Estonian Presidency in October Europeana will organise a similar strategy meeting to those of preceding presidencies for the policy makers in cultural heritage. This time we will use the opportunity to test the Impact Framework that will have been further developed with a set of tools and case studies impkt.tools by the Europeana Impact Taskforce and discuss if and how it can be implemented at country level in Europe.
