



5	A little bit confusing, I understand the underlying connectivity of different stories through the items, but could be confusing for some users.









1	It was easy to create a story, but I have problem uploading objects. I uploaded the image but could not add it to the story. I also miss instructions how to add objects from Europeana.
2	Difficulties when uploading my own material; It is not clear which element from My library is allready added to the story. I expected some feedback (help,hints) what to do when I failed to upload my own material, not only "Could not upload file"
3	Poor UX, needs more work. Clearer steps, fewer clicks. There are to many steps from finding an item to actually see it. Drag and drop is nice.
4	Difficulties at creating the story. We haven't succeed to upload a picture and to complete storytelling process.
5	It was impossible to add my own picture (jpg, 88KB, I use the recent Google Chrome). The platform didn't accept it and the reason was not clear.
6	The least on Storytelling Platform I like the way how we add the pictures, videos and other files. This is a rather complicated process.
7	When using Chrome (26.0.1410.43) I dislike the fact that I did not managed to create the story, I could not upload any file from my PC, I keep receiving message: Could not upload file! I tried with different formats, but result remained the same.  After switching to Mozzila Firefox (20.0) I managed to uplad images from my computer but that was all, I did not managed to connect (or to add in) my story with no other content from the web or europeana
8	placing the "my library" between the objects you need to import and the story destroys the logical realiton in you storybuilding - you should be able to drag your blocks directly into the story and later review you "items".
9	Very hard to figure out how to connect items with the story, when to do it, how... I could not upload any image, the system reported every time that file could not be uploaded.
